

~Fees and Financial Policies 2011-2012~

These policies apply to the Memphis area campuses only.

Tuition can be paid by the year or in nine monthly installments. If electing to pay by the year, the yearly payment is due on August 1, 2011. Monthly tuition and fees are to be paid by the 1st of every month. Tuition charges begin in August and end in April. A late fee of \$40.00 will be assessed when payment is received after the 10th of the month.
